School Calendar

"School year" under the School Act means a year commencing on July 1 and ending the following June 30, divided into two terms, the first ending December 31 and the second commencing January 1.

For practical purposes, the school year is determined by the School Board in accordance with the School Act. The calendar states the opening and closing dates for public schools, the statutory and school holidays, and the number of days schools shall be in session for teachers and for students.

In addition to regular holidays, any school day may be proclaimed a holiday by the Minister.
