## **Parents' Advisory Council**

The Board of Education (Richmond) believes that the involvement of parents in the schools enhances the quality of education in the district.

Parents must be given an opportunity to have meaningful and substantive dialogue with the schools on topics related to common educational needs and concerns.

The Board of Education (Richmond) requires each school principal to establish a school parent advisory council to facilitate this dialogue before October 31 of each year.
