Richmond Child Care Referral Centre (CCRR)

Richmond's CCRR centre provides essential support and information for families, helping connect parents with local care options and helping guide them through the process. The CCRR service is available in both English and Chinese. Referrals can be done in-person, over the phone, or via e-mail.

As part of a free child care referral, they will:

- Learn more about your family and your specific child care needs
- Explain the different types of child care available in Richmond
- Discuss other factors, like location, teaching method, and hours of operation
- Provide you with a list of child care facilities that meet your criteria

BC Government Child Care Map

British Columbia families can access an online map that takes the guesswork out of searching for child care. The Child Care Map provides parents quick, at-a-glance information that shows – for each facility in a parent's desired location – what programs are offered, if there are any available spaces, contact information, hours of operation and more. This is one of only three child-care maps in all of Canada that show which centres have vacancies.
