Reading is understanding.

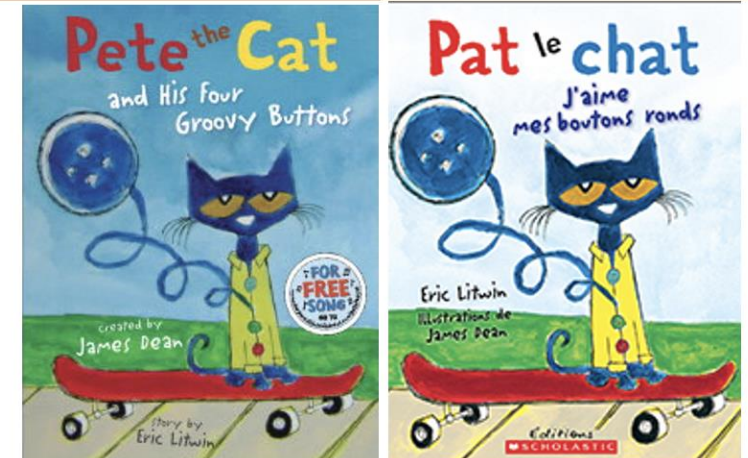
- Making meaning

- Turn on French subtitles when watching video clips, shows, and movies


